Mr. Charles William Theodore "Ted" Easterday passed away Friday afternoon, June 28, 2019 at his home surrounded by his loving family. Ted was born Saturday, September 21, 1940 in Columbus, Ohio to Charles and Dolly (Cranmer) Easterday. When Ted was nine years old, the family moved to Butte where he was raised and educated. In 1987 he earned his bachelor's degree in Occupational Safety from Montana Tech, graduating with honors.

He and Eldora Ballensky were united in marriage here in Butte in 1961 and together they raised three children.

Ted was a member of the Nazarene Church for many years, was a biblical scholar and loved to share the scriptures. He worked several jobs throughout his career including as a foreman for Parson's during the construction of the Clyde E. Weed Concentrator, worked at S.J. Perry, was a substitute teacher and welding teacher for the Butte School District, worked for the Anaconda Company as a machinist and welder, worked as a Corrections Officer at the Montana State Prison and was a highly respected private investigator and an expert firearms witness for Ruger.
