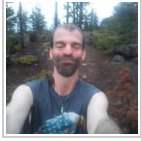
She is preceded in death by her husband Butch (Forrest) and granddaughter Virginia.

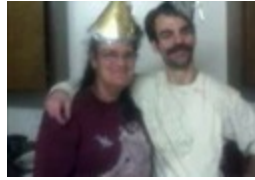
