Corrine Elizabeth Graham died Wednesday evening at St. Patrick's Hospital in Missoula. Corrine was born in Butte on June 18, 1933 to John and Cora (Lanyon) Bennetts. She attended Whittier and Butte High schools before marrying Hugh "Skip" Graham on December 5, 1949. Together, they raised two daughters, Corrine and Brenda, who were both at her side when she passed away.

When her husband/driver passed away, she got her first driver's license at age 62. Santa and the Easter Bunny never missed Gramma Skip's house. The Halloween costumes she made for her grandchildren are

legendary. She made note of every accomplishment. Birthdays were celebrated and served as her Keno numbers on her visits to the Oasis.
