She loved to garden and her yard was always beautiful in the summer. Delsie was an avid golfer and snow skier well into her later years.

Out of high school, she worked as a book-keeper at Metals Bank, and then worked at home for many years making custom draperies while her sons were in school. Later she worked as a teller at the Silver Bow School Employees Credit Union, now called Ed Tech. She was a member of Aldersgate United Methodist Church.
