



Edward Steven "Steve" Rohret

Edward "Steve" Rohret died peacefully on Friday September 27th in Butte. Steve was born on February 20, 1947, to Ed and Ellen Rohret in Butte. He will always be remembered for his love of life, gentle nature and commitment to his family and friends.

Some of the happiest times of his life were spent at his cabin, in the Tobacco Root Mountains with his wife Sharon and their family and many friends. Steve graduated from Butte High School and attended the University of Montana. After his first year of college, he joined the US Navy and was stationed on the U.S.S. Lyman K. Swenson Destroyer, based out of San Diego. He served many tours off the coast of Vietnam during the war as a radioman. After the military, Steve worked for Boyles Brothers Drilling, Lavelle Powder, Pegasus Gold and Golden Sunlight Mine.

He married his wife Sharon in 1976, and they were inseparable for 42 years until her death in 2018.

His favorite activities included spending time riding his four-wheeler in the Tobacco Root Mountains, target practice, attending "hunting" camp in Dillon with the Smith's and most of all, he cherished time spent telling stories around the campfire.

Steve was preceded in death by wife Sharon Rohret: his Parents; daughter Rochelle Aultman, Son Larry Church and grandson Evan Church and sister-in-law Teri Rohret.
