Edwin Eugene Engle passed away Friday, May 17, 2024 from injuries suffered in a fall from a ladder. He was born Friday, August 20, 1948 in Lemmon, South Dakota to Edwin and Clara (Hay) Engle. The family moved to Butte when Edwin was two years old and he attended schools in Butte, graduating from Butte High School.

Ed worked for Bob Wallace and Ralph Dowland before being drafted into the United State Army. He proudly served his country in Vietnam and following his honorable discharge returned to Butte where he started his career as an automobile mechanic with the Anaconda Company. Following the ACM shutdown, he went to work at Paul's Chevrolet in Dillon then Whalen Tire in Dillon then Lisac's here in Butte and finally with the State of Montana Department of Transportation where he retired. Ed was really a "jack of all trades" and a pretty darn good handy man. He was a longtime member of Gold Hill Lutheran Church and served on the Trust Committee there. He and Connie also enjoyed their monthly 55+ lunches.

On October 21, 1967 he and Connie Hatch were united in marriage in Gold Hill Lutheran Church and together they had two daughters, Tammie and Tabatha. Tammie preceded him in death on August 6, 2022. He is also preceded in death by his parents, his sister, Marian, brother Bobby, Connie's parents Fred and Lois Hatch, brother-in-law, Bill Hatch and sister-in-law, Cynthia "Cid" Fischer.
