



## Floyd E. Saari

February 1, 1930 - July 15, 2016

Mr. Floyd E. Saari passed away Friday morning in a local nursing home. He was born February 1, 1930 in Oakes, North Dakota to Elmer and Hattie (Scheffert) Saari. He attended schools in Oakes and then served with the United States Marine Corp. in Korea. Following his honorable discharge he returned to North Dakota for a brief career in farming before coming to Montana in the late 1950's. He lived in Anaconda and worked as a carpenter for the B.A. & P. Railroad. Floyd then moved to Butte, working first as an underground miner then as a shovel operator in the Berkeley Pit, a job he was very good at and quite proud of. He retired in 1979 and enjoyed fishing, camping, traveling and several gambling trips to Las Vegas. Floyd was a very private person, extremely hard working and a perfectionist at his craft. He married Eugenia Andrade in Anaconda on June 25, 1966 and she survives. Also surviving is his mother-in-law, Esperanza Andrade of Butte, brother-in-law and sisters-in-law, Aurelio "Butch" and Virginia Andrade of Butte and Cecilia Andrade of Phoenix, AZ, sisters-in-law, Judy Saari and Ilene Wald.
