



Glenn Gordon Gerry

November 25, 1944 - February 14, 2022

Mr. Glenn Gordon Gerry passed away Monday, February 14, 2022 at his home in Butte with his wife, Sue at his side. Glenn was born Saturday, November 25, 1944 in Britton South Dakota. He was adopted by Stanley and Marie (Daly) Gerry, and was raised and educated in Butte, graduating from Butte High School in 1963. He earned a bachelor's degree in history and education from Western Montana College in Dillon in 1970 and on July 18th of that same year married Susan Kay Jackson in Aldersgate United Methodist Church. Glenn taught high school in Broadus, Montana and returned to Butte in 1972 where he worked for Walt Bazzanella at the Husky Station in Rocker. Glenn then worked for the Lisac's for over 20 years until his retirement. He enjoyed bowling and bowled on several leagues. He earned his private pilot's license and he and Sue also enjoyed flying together. They also enjoyed motorcycling together. Glenn was a member of the B.P. O. E. # 240 Butte Elk's Lodge and served as Exalted Ruler twice, first in 1989-1990 and again in 1996-1997. He belonged to the Christian Motorcycle Club and was a past Vice President.

Glenn is survived by his wife Sue Gerry of Butte and a nephew in Hamilton. Cremation has taken place. Memorial services will be conducted at a later date and interment will be in a Butte.
