Mr. James Edward Clark Jr. passed away Monday at Continental Care and Rehabilitation Center where he had lived since December 7, 2013. He was born in Butte Thursday, September 13, 1951 to James E and Cecilia (Chavez) Clark. James attended the Madison School, East Junior High and Butte High School.

He cleaned For Butte-Silver Bow at the corral from 1970 until 1976 and for School District # 1 from 1983 until 2000 and was honored by the school district for his years of service.
