James Marcus Devich passed away Sunday, April 19, 2026 at his home in Anaconda with his family at his side. James was raised in Anaconda and attended Anaconda High School where he excelled at basketball. He attended some college before joining the United States Army. Following his honorable discharge James returned to Anaconda where he worked as a clerk at the court house then at the smelter until it shut down. James went to work at The Montana State Prison as a correctional officer until his retirement, enjoyed golfing and bowling and was flattered to have won several Elvis impersonator contests. Jim also drove the DAV van, shuttling veterans to and from medical appointments.

He married his wife Toni in Butte on December 27, 1975 and she survives.
