Mr. James "Jim" Sestrich passed away Christmas Morning, December 25, 2019 at the Bee Hive Home in Butte. He was born Friday, January 17, 1936 in Anaconda, Montana and was raised and educated there. He went to work at a very young age and served his country in the United States Navy.

Jim married Margaret June "Peggy" Shea in the Immaculate Conception Church on October 21, 1961 and shortly after moved to Great Falls for about a year before moving to Los Banos, California where Jim worked as an iron worker on the San Luis Reservoir Project.
