Jane Ash, 81, of Arnoldsville, Georgia, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 7, 2025 in Deer Lodge, Montana. She was born in Social Circle, Georgia on November 10, 1943 to Harry and Grace Chandler and went to Monroe Area High School. There, she played basketball, was on the yearbook committee, and was a member of the FHA, glee, pep, and Tri-Hi-Y clubs. Her senior year quote was, "The willing worker will always be rewarded."

Upon graduation, Jane moved to Atlanta to attend modeling school. She was chosen from her class to work as a tour guide at Stone Mountain Park. Later, she worked as a telephone operator for Southern Bell in Athens. She went on to work for the post office and retired as postmaster. One of the highlights of her career was being selected to be a part of a special Postal Service envoy for the 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta.

Jane lived in Arnoldsville, Georgia for over 50 years... one of which she served as the town mayor. She was a member of Arnoldsville Baptist Church, where she had taught Sunday school and had sang in the choir.
