Jeannette was greeted in Heaven by her loving grandparents Susan Podgorski, Edwin A. Messer, and William and Martha Peltier.

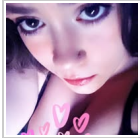

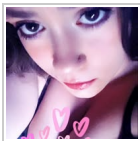
