



Keith L. Ingram

July 7, 1952 - February 8, 2026

Keith Ingram was never at a loss for a joke. His quips weren't always polite, but each was delivered with a hearty laugh and abundant good cheer.

Keith was born on July 23, 1952 in Salmon, Idaho to Patricia Kopp Fletcher and Leroy Ingram. After a few years in Billings, Keith and his younger brother Doug moved with their mother to Butte where Keith graduated from Butte High School in 1970.

Keith's first job was as a steelworker for the ACM company in Anaconda and then, until its closing twelve years later, at Butte's Concentrator. In 1984, sensing a business opportunity in our often windy city, Keith founded Big Sky Seamless Rain Gutter. As sole proprietor and chief installer, he designed and manufactured custom gutters. The venture proved successful, remaining in business until a year ago.

On April 6, 1976, Keith married Agnes Seymour. They moved into the house on Missouri Avenue that would be the Ingram home to this day. In 1984, they welcomed a son, Keith Thomas Ingram. This spring would have been Agnes and Keith's 50th anniversary.

No story about Keith's life can be told without sharing his love of the internal combustion engine. He was a lifelong fan of motorcycles and classic cars,

particularly vintage Chevys. Keith and Agnes were longtime members of the Montana Classic Chevy Club. It's not an exaggeration to say that over the years Keith bought, sold, and traded more vehicles than many used car lots.

Among his other interests, Keith regularly bowled for Marty's and Dano's teams, both bars famous for attracting a colorful clientele. In that circle, he was known to many as Skip Ingram.

On Sunday, Feb 8, 2026 Keith died unexpectedly. He is survived by his wife Agnes, son Keith and stepdad Ron Fletcher of Salt Lake City.

The family asks that any memorials in Keith's name be made to a charity of the donor's choice. A celebration of Keith's life will be announced at a later date.
