Leonard William Hoscheid Jr. 81 passed away March 7, 2019 at home surrounded by his family.

He was born Thursday, April 1st 1937 in Baudette MN to Leonard William Hoscheid Sr and Gertrude (Duffy) Hoscheid, the eldest of nine children. He grew up working on the family farm, fishing and hunting. He developed a special bond with his cousin, George Swentik that lasted his entire life. He attended schools in Baudette MN and graduated high school in 1955. He dated and married the love of his life, Iris Mae Strand on Nov 5, 1955.

Leonard and Iris removed the back seat in their 1947 Ford, loaded their wedding gifts and moved to Anaconda MT the next day.

They were blessed with 6 children, 19 grandchildren, and 30 great grandchildren.

Leonard went to work for the Anaconda Co where he became a Brick Layer and later a supervisor. After the closure of the Anaconda Smelter in 1980, Leonard started Hoscheid Masonry where he employed his sons, grandsons, and many others. "May The Work I Have Done Speak For Me".

He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather and taught us the value of hard work. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and camping.

He was an active member of the Anaconda Catholic Community, Knights of Columbus, the Anaconda Kiwanis, and The Anaconda Chamber of Commerce. He was a retired member of the West Valley Volunteer Fire Department.

Leonard was preceded in death by his parents Leonard and Gertrude, his sons Daniel and Stephen, his brothers Frank Hoscheid, Patrick Hoscheid, and sister Agnes (Hoscheid).

There are a couple of life changing events you gave to me personally. #1: It was the winter of 1986, you were doing some repair work on the Mormon Church in Butte. I was lucky enough to be working for you at the time. There were seven of us, 4 bricklayers and three hod carriers bricking the storage shed at the church. You vowed "Nobody gets laid off on Christmas Eve". The job was so small, one guy would spread mud and the guy behind him would lay a brick. You could have sent me home, but you didn't. Nobody else would have that compassion.

#2: I had not worked for 7 months. You came to my house on my Birthday and said, "I'm going to build the Rivendell Hospital, you want a job?" For the next six months you saw to it I had a job, and when the end came, you patted me on the back and said "Well kid we'll see ya on the next big job." That never happened because I hung up my tools and never worked as a bricklayer again. But, I NEVER forgot your life changing attitude toward people. You are one Special person that will forever live..... God Bless you, and I will see you "On the next big Job."
