Until we see you again, we love you.

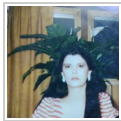

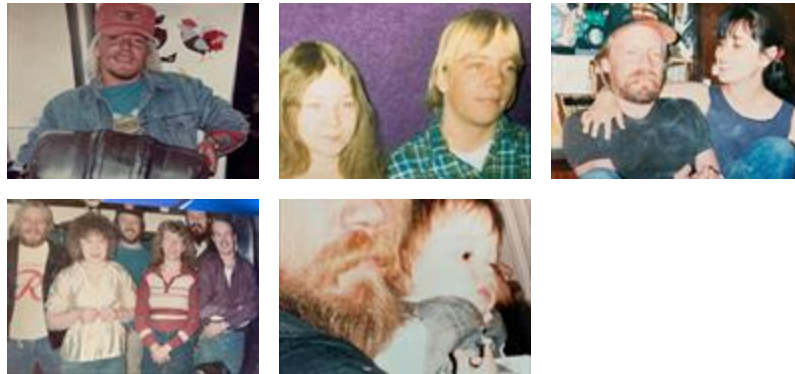
