Our Dad, Robert Cardoso, 57, passed away unexpectedly on April 23, 2024. Born on April 12, 1967, in El Paso, Texas, he was the second born child to John and Barbara Cardoso. As a child the family relocated to Chula Vista, California where he was raised and met his soulmate, Julie Little Cardoso, at Bonita Vista High School. The two were instantly inseparable and went on to raise two children, daughter, Katy Kooyman, and son, Johnny Cardoso.

As a kid his friends and family remember him being wild, but doing it with skill. His calm and collected demeanor won everyone over. Robert's siblings looked up to him like a Dad and he taught and nurtured them in his own way. He wasn't a brother who picked on you. We will cherish his guidance and bravery and always hold on to the good he instilled in us. Friends remember hanging out at the house, and Dad making sure everyone was well fed, taken care of, and part of the family. He was always a phone call away and ended every conversation with “love yaz.” Our dad loved to laugh, relax, and ‘get stuff done.’ He had a unique, determined, resilient way of navigating life. Dad taught us to stand up for what we believe in. Although it is hard to believe he is no longer physically with us, we know he is at peace and forever with us until we meet again. We're proud of all you did during your short time with us, Dad.

Robert was met on the other side by his mom and dad, Barbara and John Cardoso; older brother, Mony Cardoso; father in law, Tony Caliger; our family dog of 16 years, Hunny girl, and our kitty of 10 years, Roxy.
