Robert Earl Wiens passed away Friday, August 5th, 2022 at his home in Butte following a lengthy illness. He was Born Saturday, December 21, 1957 in Richardton, North Dakota to Roland and Mary (Menke) Wiens. The family moved to Livingston, Montana when Bob was a small child and he was raised there, graduating from Park County High School. Bob also attended Montana Tech in Butte. He was a longtime and active member of First Baptist Church.

Never one to be idle, he kept very busy with work and service to others. He delivered the Montana Standard newspaper, worked for and with C. Owen Smithers, belonged to the Gideons and packed literally thousands of sack lunches for the homeless. He worked as master control operator at KXLF TV and later for Family Dollar Store. He had a rich and extensive knowledge of Butte history, loved music and loved to sing. He didn't know how to say "no" and was so generous with his time in helping others.
