Vady Stratton, a wonderful stay at home mother, passed away Wednesday, September 21, 2016 at her residence in Butte. She will be greatly missed. She was born in Butte January 27, 1925 to John L. and Hattie (Mulder) DeCorey and attended local schools including the Greeley, Butte High School and graduated from the Butte Business College. She and Howard W. Stratton were married in Butte November 26, 1944 and together made their home in the Highlands until their kids started school in Butte and then lived every summer in the Highlands.

Vady worked in the Portland Shipyard during World War II and at the Shoetorium before marriage then in the food services at Montana Tech for fourteen years. She was a longtime member of Gold Hill Lutheran Church and had a profound love for nature and all animals. When the Stratton's moved from the Highlands, much like St. Francis, Vady was more concerned about the fate of all her visiting animals than her own.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Howard, on May 27, 1994 and by all three of her brothers. Survivors include her children: Gloria and Jim Rogers of Whitehall, Bob and Peggy Stratton of Twin Lakes, Idaho, Alice and Ron Lester of Grants Pass, Oregon, Mark and Etta Stratton of Butte, Margie and Tommi Haikka of Helena, Dave Stratton of Butte and Howard Stratton of Gladstone, Oregon. Also surviving are twenty six grandchildren, seventeen great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren. Vady had a great love for music, and she left on a beautiful note.
