



## William L. Barth

July 14, 1924 - February 20, 2018

Mr. William L. Barth passed away Tuesday, February 20, 2018. He was born Monday, July 14, 1924 in Portland, Oregon to William and Regina (Casper) Barth. Bill served his country in the United States Navy during World War II and following his discharge attended Montana School of Mines where he earned his degree in engineering. He worked in the oil fields of Wyoming for a period of time then returned to Butte where he worked for the Anaconda Company. He and his wife Roberta operated a dairy farm in Wisconsin from 1961 to 1966 but returned to Butte where he eventually retired as a boss in the Berkeley Pit.

He was a longtime member of St. Ann's Parish and made his Cursillo in the late 1980's. He was preceded in death by his son William, his wife Roberta, sisters: Lorraine Childs, Irene Norris, and Kathleen Rebish as well as his brothers Jack, Clarence and George Barth. He is survived by 11 nieces and nephews including Regina and Eric Kaupanger of Phoenix, Arizona, Arthur "Art" Childs of Butte, Ted and Anita Childs of Mesa, Arizona and numerous great nieces and nephews.
