William Charles "Bill" Haft passed away Tuesday morning, October 15, 2024 in St. James Healthcare in Butte. He was born in Butte, Monday, June 20, 1938 to Ed and Hilma (Hubred) Haft. He attended the Greeley School and Butte High School.

Immediately after high school he joined the US Navy and served on the USS Princeton, an Essex Class aircraft carrier. Following his discharge, he returned to Butte and worked for the B.A. & P. Railroad before starting his 37 year career with the Montana Power Company as a lineman. He lived in Drummond from 1985 until his retirement.
