



William Charles Hitchens

June 21, 1943 - February 15, 2023

Mr. William Charles Hitchens passed away early Wednesday morning, February 15, 2023 at his home in Butte. He was born in Butte Monday, June 21, 1943 to Russell C. and Thelma (Sime) Hitchens. He attended McKinley School, Butte High School and Butte Vo-Tech where he earned his certification as a Machinist. He served his country in the United States Army for 4 years and another 24 years in the Army Reserves. William worked as a Machinist for the Anaconda Company until its closure in 1982 then went to work as a correctional officer at the Montana State Prison in 1985 until his retirement in 2007.

He was a member of the American Legion, Mile High Chapter of the H.O.G. (Harley Owners Group) loved riding his Harley with his Butte Rats and enjoyed four-wheeling in his Jeeps. He loved his dog Thor, but his entire world revolved around family, especially his grandchildren and his great grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by his sisters, Rae Rau and Beth Kovich, his grandson, Sean Patrick Nugent and his former wife and good friend, Judi Coleman.

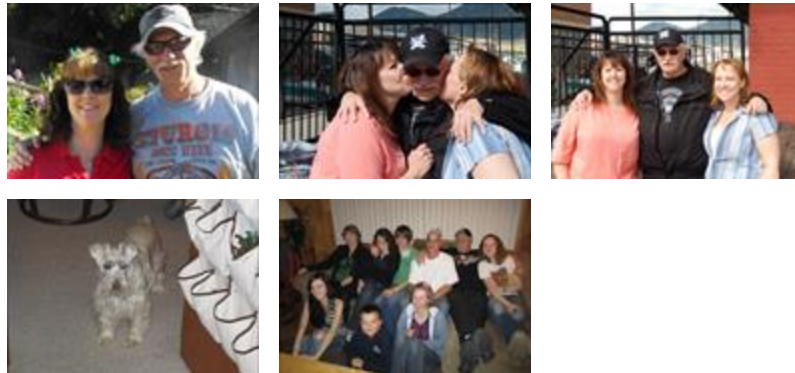
